






your At Home Easter Egg Hunt

Directions:


- 1. Find the "Easter Egg-stravaganza Story Sheet" in this packet. You will need one for each child.
- 2. Cut out the Easter story pictures (below) for each child. Fold the pictures up so they fit inside of a plastic Easter egg.
- 3. Place candy or treats in plastic eggs and the story pictures in others. We included some to use. Hide the eggs around your house or yard.
- 4. Before hunting for the eggs, go to *thecompass.net/CompassKids* and click on the Easter Egg Hunt video link. The video will tell you when to begin searching. Pause the video when prompted.
- 5. When the story pictures have all been found, encourage your children to glue/tape them on the Story Sheet in the order of the Easter story.
- 6. Begin playing the video again. The video will reveal the correct order while telling the the Easter story.
- 7. There are also coloring sheets for each of the Easter story pictures so you can color them while you are enjoying your Easter candy.

- Candy or other small treats
- Tape or glue stick








