- ◆ MASKS will be required for all children Age 2 and older according to the current CDC Guidelines. Children under Age 2 should not wear masks.
- We will be taking children's TEMPERATURES before they are able to check-in to their classrooms. We continue to ask that children exhibiting any sickness remain at home and enjoy their CompassKids lesson online.
- Our STAIRWAYS WILL BECOME ONE-WAY and will be clearly marked.
- We are recommending our ONLINE PRE-REGISTRATION in order to ensure that your child has a space reserved during our weekend services.
- We will be implementing a TOUCH-LESS CHECK-IN system. You will be asked to provide your phone number and our team will print out your children's tags.
- We will be launching the following NEW CLASSROOMS in order to keep our children socially distanced: Ages 4-5, Grades K-1, Grades 2-3 and Grades 4-5.
- ◆ We will be social distancing in all our classrooms by LOWERING OUR CAPACITIES by more than 50%. This means we will be closing classrooms as soon as we reach these safety limits.
- ◆ All children will be offered HAND-SANITIZER as they enter and exit their classroom.
- NO PARENTS OR GUARDIANS will be allowed in our classrooms. Drop off and pickup up will take place at the door.
- NO PERSONAL ITEMS will be allowed in our classrooms, including coats/jackets. We will provide labeled zip-lock bags for essential items that must remain with your child (i.e. diapers, pacifiers, bottles etc.). Diaper bags and jackets can remain outside the classroom in the hallways.
- ◆ Our CLASSROOMS WILL BE CLUTTER-FREE AND SANITIZED before each service. Toys and supplies will be labeled and sanitized specifically for each service.
