3. Reread Galatians 4:5a (NLT) God sent him to buy freedom for us who were slaves to the law.

What did Jesus pay in order to buy our freedom?

4. Reread Galatians 4:5 (NLT) God sent him to buy freedom for us who were slaves to the law, so that he could adopt us as his very own children.

What are the benefits of being adopted into God's family?

- 6. What spiritual truth makes you grateful at Christmas?
