The Wonder of Christmas Week 1: He is the Word

John 1:1-3

Week of November 29, 2020 (Jeff Griffin, Senior Pastor)

We kicked off a new four-week series on the prologue of the Gospel of John. These eighteen verses will provide us a theological description of the birth of Jesus. This series promises to help us appreciate Christmas like never before! The first week was a study of the meaning of Christ as the Word!

Kicking it off: Tell us about your Christmas tree. Real or fake? White or colored lights? Pre-lit? Homemade ornaments?

Discussion:

- 1. Reread John 1:14 The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us.
 - In the first century, both philosophers and theologians celebrated the concept of "The Word." Why did John use this popular term?
- 2. Reread *John 1:1-3* In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was with God in the beginning. Through him all things were made.
 - The baby lying in the manger looked like a normal child, but actually He was extraordinary in many ways. What do these verses tell us about the unique nature of Jesus?
- 3. Jeff declared that Jesus is an amazing intersection of "Transcendence" and "Imminence." What does this mean?
- 4. Jeff shared of being "starstruck" when meeting Bear's legend Mike Singletary. Why are we not more starstruck when meeting God through prayer?
- 5. How does the birth of Christ reveal God's desire for a relationship with us?
- 6. What makes you feel relationally connected to God?
- 7. What could you do to deepen your relationship with the Lord?

Wrapping It Up: Pray that this Christmas season will be a time of unique renewal in our relationship with God.
